### POSTER AND ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

All accepted abstracts are presented as posters during CICON25. From all accepted abstracts, authors of highly rated abstracts are selected to deliver oral short talk presentations of their submitted work in addition to their poster presentation.

If abstract authors have not received a short talk invitation, their abstract has not been selected for a short talk by the abstract review committee.

If an abstract is not accepted for poster presentation, the presenter may request a full refund of the registration fee by contacting [cicon@wikonect.de](mailto:cicon@wikonect.de).

However, if your abstract is accepted but not selected for a short talk presentation, this policy does not apply.

All accepted abstracts will be published online approximately one week before the meeting. The abstracts will also be published in the CICON25 conference app, which will be available during the conference.

### POSTER DISPLAY

Abstract authors receive their conference abstract number and their poster session schedule together with their abstract presentation notification.

The CICON poster boards will measure 1 meter (39.37 inches) wide by 1.4 meters (55.12 inches) high. We recommend the European DinA0 format for your poster prints. For posters produced in the United States, we recommend 36 × 48 inches (Arch E format).

- Poster boards will be numbered.
- Posters are displayed during the length of the conference.
- Mounting material will be made available on site.
- There is no poster printing facility on site

### ORAL TALK IN SHORT-TALK SESSION

Abstract presenters selected for short talk presentation are notified by email of their session schedule. Short-talk presenters will have 10 minutes for the oral talk and an additional 5 minutes for discussion.

Please hand in your presentation to the technician at the speakers registration desk with enough time to spare.

You may want to carry a second data storage device in case there is any unsolvable technical problem.

Please note that the projection ratio is 16:9. Please contact us if your presentation requires any special technical set-up.
